Plate Jointer (Biscuit Cutter)

I. Competencies


Given a properly adjusted plate jointer, accessories, instruction and demonstration of use, each student will be able to:

- A. Identify the major parts of the plate jointer.
- B. Pass a written test on safety and operating procedures of the plate jointer with 100 percent accuracy.
- C. Demonstrate ability to use the plate jointer, following suggested safety rules and correct operation procedures.

II. Instructional Materials and Procedures

- A. Identification of Basic Plate Jointer Parts.
 - 1. Hand Knob
 - 2. Off/On Switch
 - 3. Handle
 - 4. Electrical Cord

- 5. Cord Strain Reliever
- 6. Base
- 7. Blade
- 8. Centering Stop



B. Plate Jointer Safety

- 1. Wear safety glasses at all times when using the plate jointer.
- 2. Make sure the switch is in the off position before the plate jointer is plugged in.
- 3. Keep the power cord positioned away from the work to be to be performed to avoid cutting the cord.
- 4. Make sure the plate jointer is unplugged while adjustments are being made.
- 5. Secure the material to be jointed before attempting to make a cut.
- 6. Have a firm grip on the plate jointer with both hands before turning the switch on.
- 7. Never operate the plate jointer in damp or wet locations.
- 8. When using the plate jointer outside always connect it to a ground fault circuit interrupter (GFCI).
- 9. Do not lay the plate jointer down until the blade has come to a complete stop.
- 10. Do not wear loose clothing, rings, or bracelets while operating the plate jointer.
- 11. Disconnect the electrical cord on the plate jointer before leaving the work area.

C. Operating Procedures

- 1. Adjust the centering stop so the jointer will cut the biscuit slot in the middle of the edge of the boards to be jointed.
- 2. Mark the center of all biscuit slot locations before any cuts are made.
- 3. Align the center notch on the plate jointer with the center mark on the boards to be jointed.
- 4. Allow the centering stop to rest flush on top of each board to be jointed.
- 5. Clamp or secure each board before making the cut(s) for biscuit(s).

- 6. Turn the plate jointer on and push the spring loaded base in (toward the board). This will expose the blade which will then cut the slot for the biscuit.
- 7. The plate jointer must be adjusted to cut the correct size slot. There are three different biscuit sizes used for jointery, the plate jointer will have a setting for each size biscuit, adjust accordingly.




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


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
